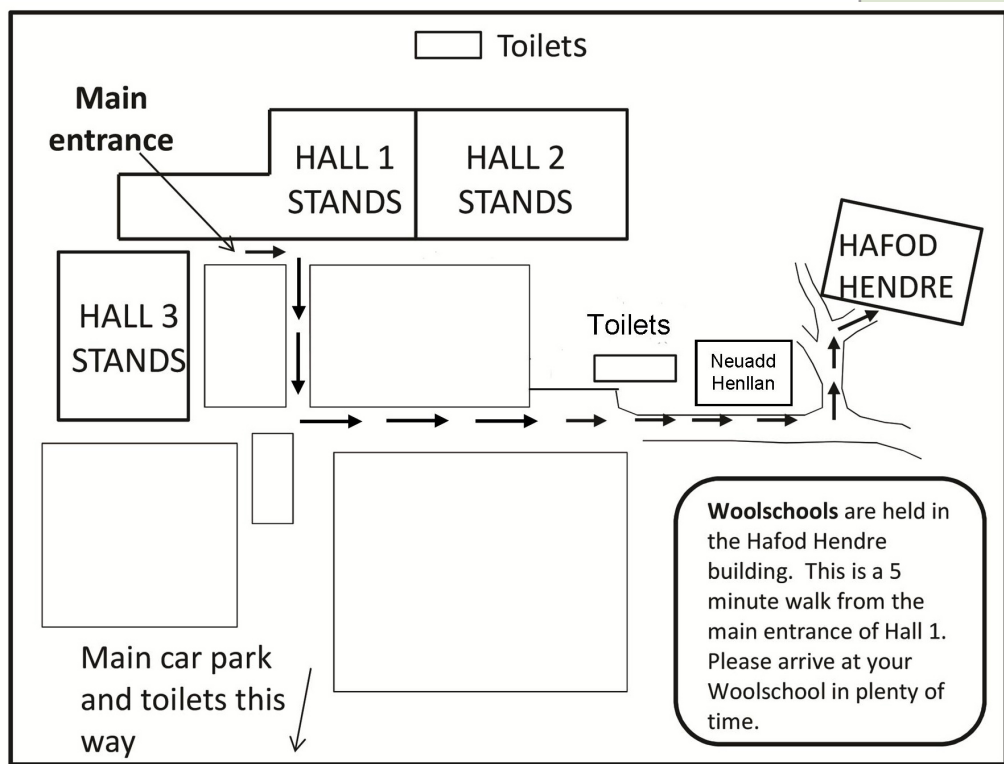

DIRECTIONS MAP FOR WOOLSCHOOLS



Woolschools take place in the **Hafod Hendre building**. You will need to allow time to get there (see map above) and plan to **arrive 15 minutes before the start of your workshop** to allow for ticket scanning etc.

For pre-booked workshop places, the Woolschool Steward will scan your ticket when you enter the Hafod Hendre building. Students who buy tickets on the day will be issued with a receipt to gain entry to the Woolschool. **Please remember to get your hand stamped on the way out of the Show so that you can return after your Woolschool.**

WONDERWOOL WALES SUPPORTING CHARITIES

Wonderwool Wales has been supporting charities for many years now by giving the money collected from the Bag Creche, Exhibitions and Mini Buses. One of our chosen charities is the **WALES AIR AMBULANCE** which is a vital service for all those living in & visiting Wales. The Fundraising Ravellers Area in Hall 1 also raises money at the show through the sale of donated wool, magazines etc. The WAA rely purely on donations to run the service.



THE KNITTED KNOCKERS is a registered UK charity which handknits or crochets bespoke replacement breast prostheses in

100% cotton for mastectomy patients. The Knockers are provided free of charge.

Do visit them on stand E6, you might like to join them in their knitting endeavours aiding cancer patients.



NGO MOLOTOK is a cultural organisation that was established more than 10 years ago in the village of Nyzhnie Selyshche in Ukraine, to support young people from disadvantaged rural communities and to help them access art workshops, classes and festivals. Since the full scale invasion of Ukraine, this organisation has become a shelter for around 100 young people and families from affected areas of Ukraine. They provide daily food, accommodation and activities for children

and young people. Volunteers also work to overcome their traumatic experiences.

SHEEPWALK

The Sheepwalk takes place on the stage in Hall 3 at 12.30 & 3.00pm each day and is where our exhibitors show you their wonderful creations.



V.E.DAY EXHIBITION IN HALL 3

When I first had my lightbulb moment I really had no idea that it would lead to this incredible roller coaster I've been on for almost 2 years... 250,000 people have been through to visit us. The same in money raised!

It's all got a lot bigger than first envisaged as our original plan of 'we'll give surplus funds to veteran charities'.

The enthusiasm surrounding this project exemplifies how commemorative activities can stimulate local economies and foster connections within communities. Through our efforts, we've actually strengthened the relationship between historical remembrance and local engagement, demonstrating that celebrating history can also yield remarkable economic benefits. Wherever we've been we've had cafes and shops selling out...in fact news headlines on 2 occasions how we've increased trade!

Due to the positive reception and success we have experienced, we are excited to further develop our initiatives to ensure that these significant commemorations continue to be recognised. We have therefore commissioned this second 80-meter project titled "Britain at War," which examines how Britain navigated the war from September 3rd to VE Day, here at Wonderwool you are the very first to see the start of the 80 panel work we are currently working on. A roll out of panels is taking place until 3rd September 2025 at Southwell Minster where we will unveil the whole 80 panels.

In addition to producing two major works, that have drawn comparisons to the modern Bayeux Tapestry, we aim to strengthen our community through various projects such as the Poppy Cascades in France and Britain, for example we'll be undertaking a major installation for Peterborough Cathedral!

Currently, we are collaborating with College Gambetta here in France to help children learn and engage with the arts. However, we aspire to involve older community members as well. The potential for larger creations is immense, and we envision opportunities for husbands and local businesses to participate actively in these initiatives! For example we are attempting to create a life size jeep in knit/crochet. Our aim is to do this across The British Isles.

The Longest Yarn remains committed to honouring our past while promoting and supporting local communities across the nation.

THE BLYTH TALL SHIP WILLIAMS GANSEY PROJECT

Here we are again – and how wonderful to be back. The gansey project and its project leaders, Astrid Adams and Janice Snowball have been coming to Wonderwool Wales every year since 2016 (except for a gap during Covid).

Although the Williams gansey remains a key part of the project, we have widened our horizons, developing a series of 12-inch blanket squares with geometric and marine based patterns. These have been used to provide warm, cosy blankets for people staying on board our Tall Ship Williams II. We have also developed small hot water bottle covers – again for people staying onboard to provide a bit of extra warmth on cold nights. These patterns are on display and on sale at the Gansey stall.

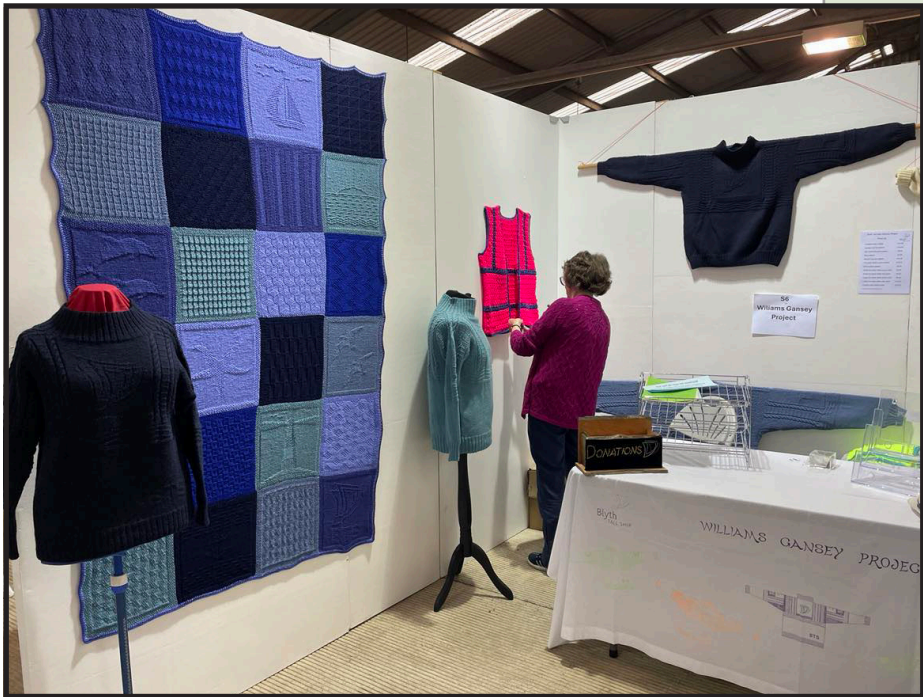
If you're not familiar with the project, the Williams Gansey was designed by Janice and Astrid as the 'uniform' for the crew of the Williams II when it sailed round Britain in ten legs between March and May 2019.

Publicity that was launched through Northumberland County council for the Gansey Project helped to recruit volunteer knitters to make around 125 ganseys needed for the project. In fact it resulted in responses from almost 600 knitters living all over the world. You can find out more about the gansey project at the stall.

We have also developed small hot water bottle covers – again for people staying onboard to provide a bit of extra warmth on cold nights. These patterns are on display and on sale at the Gansey stall.
